The Financial Year 1996-97 has been full of achievements for Bharti Enterprises. The long awaited licence for M.P. Basic Services was awarded in the month of February. Bharti, with its partner STET, is all set to become the first Basic Service operator in the country.

AirTel, the leader in mobile telephony, continues to maintain its No.1 position in the country, with 75,000 subscribers on its network. AirTel is the first network in the nation to go for an all-out expansion drive. A new Switch Site at Vikas

Puri was commissioned, as part of the drive, which enhanced the capacity of the network to connect 2,00,000 subscribers. After the

commercial launch of the first phase of AirTel in H.P., it is all set to roll out the second phase in the Kulu Valley, by August-September this year. AirTel, Delhi and H.P. also successfully launched the InstaCash Card this March.

The other Group companies of Bharti Enterprises have also performed extremely well. Casio Bharti Mobile Communications has established itself in the paging market as a very strong No.2. Casio pagers are available on all the paging service networks, across the country. The Casio brand enjoys a healthy 25% share of the market and is showing signs of improving its market share in the coming year. Siemens Telecom has strengthened and consolidated its market share and maintained its leadership position in the telecom terminal segment. Both Beetel and Siemens brands increased their reach in the market, with the introduction of new products. Bharti

Telecom is setting up a Centre for Excellence in Gurgaon to support the R&D activities of both Ludhiana and Gurgaon factories. A major thrust is being given for development of new models in basic and feature phones. Bharti Telecom is all geared up to manufacture two million phones in the coming year. Bharti Healthcare has successfully completed the first phase of expansion and is in the process of completing the second and third phase. With this expansion, Bharti Healthcare will be a strong player in the hard gelatine capsule industry. A major thrust

> is being given on domestic as well as export markets. Bharti Dura-Line, a joint venture company, set up to manufacture telecom ducts has received encouraging responses

from Basic Service operators. It is well geared to start commercial production by July-August this year.

A 'Golden' story in Telecom History

Bharti Telenet Limited acquired a "Golden Halo" for itself with yet another benchmark achievement. On 28th February, 1997, it became the first Telecom company in the private sector to sign an agreement with DoT, Govt. of India, to provide basic telephone services in the state of Madhya Pradesh. At the time of the historic signing, Bharti also deposited the first instalment of the licence fees, and completed all other required documentation.

Madhya Pradesh, as India's largest state, offers a tremendous opportunity for Bharti to etch a success story in the history of Telecom Services. Mr. Sunil Bharti Mittal, Chairman and Group Managing Director of Bharti Enterprises said, "We have been preparing for this day for a long time and are ready to start rolling out our network in a very short time. A lot of groundwork has already been done, and we see in Madhya Pradesh, immense opportunities." Mr. Mittal also thanked the Telecom Commission Chairman, Mr. A. V. Gokak, and other Government authorities, for entrusting Bharti Telenet with this honourable role, one that marks the beginning of a new era of liberalisation in the Indian Telecom Sector.

Bharti Telenet has a commitment to install 50,000 lines per year for the first three years, with a total investment of Rs. 2,000 crores, spread over 5 years. Of this, 11% has been earmarked for the rural sector. To ensure expeditious

compliance with the network operations' guidelines, Bharti will install Wireless in the Local Loop technology. In the first phase, operations will commence in Indore, Bhopal, Raipur, Jabalpur and Gwalior, followed by other major cities and towns of the state.

In the first year, the high revenue and high density areas will be targeted. While providing radio access for quicker development, a special bid will be made for the industrial pockets. Later, while expanding the above activities, a fixed network will be established.

Proud to be a pioneer in the field today, Bharti Telenet is all set to establish high standards in the Indian Telecom Industry.

Global Telecom Show '97, a premier telecom exposition, organised by Wisitex foundation, was the stage where Casio Pagers were in the spotlight.






